Group with No Name

Is there anything easy in Kenya? I was planning to take about 10 to 15 teens hiking about 2 hours out of town. However, I have a very small car and can only fit a total of four including myself, so I had arranged to have two other adults join us. They often help me with the teen activities and have helped me with the transportation problem before, so I thought all was

well. And it was well until Friday afternoon about 4pm. I started receiving phone calls from the adults helping me and within a few hours of each other explaining how they could no longer help to due to car problems or family issues and they had to cancel. I was absolutely stunned at this and panic was definitely setting in at the thought of how I was going to stuff up to 15 teens into my small car. I knew that was not realistically going to happen. However, I also knew trying to find an affordable van and driver within the next few hours was going to be a bit of a challenge. Since we don't exactly have car rentals, you can't run and fix the problem so I tried the few contacts I knew to help me. By the way, when you rent a van you get the van and driver regardless, it's just the way it's done around here. Most of the quotes were about \$150.00 and that wasn't an option for my budget. As you can see things were not looking good, and I literally stopped where I was and started praying. I have to tell you about one hour later I received another call from a guy asking if I needed any more help for the trip. I immediately asked how big his car was, he said it seats about 8 teens plus himself. I was absolutely ecstatic and that's how God works. When we can't, He does... and He did! It turned out to be an awesome trip and we ended up with just enough seats to take everyone. Praise the Lord!

We went up to a place called Hells Gate and rightfully so because as you hike there are deep canyons to cross

And my answer was 'I am here to make a difference, even if its just one teens life and to show them how much Jesus loves them, I want to teach them the Word of God.' As I look over the past 10 months I can honestly say I have done exactly what I came to do, and now its time to give these awesome teens back to the Lord and let him continue however he sees fit. Only I didn't realize how hard this would be.

It has been such a blessing and a privilege to have built a teen group from scratch.
